In the last two years we have worked to improve the rights for children in countries including Azerbaijan, Bahrain, Burundi, China, Georgia, Guatemala, Kosovo, Liberia, Pakistan, Russian Federation, Rwanda, Syria, Tajikistan, Antigua, India, Kazakhstan Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan and Vietnam.
